

Dean Barber Scholarship in VISUAL ARTS

The **Dean Barber Memorial Scholarship in Visual Arts** recognizes students who have excelled in studio arts and who plan a career in the visual arts.

This award is a one-time **\$1,000 scholarship** and is based on the portfolio presentation, grades, essays, recommendation and public service. The check will be provided to the student in summer of 2009.

Scholarship Requirements:

1. Must be a Senior at Myers Park High School in good standing, plan on a career in the visual arts and be admitted to a college, university or post-secondary school.
2. Complete the enclosed application form. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
3. Include a personal résumé with your completed application.
4. Write a 250 -word essay on the following topic: "Tell us about your plans for a career in the visual arts and how your career will impart the community."
5. Include a portfolio of 10 -12 original visual art works, presented in CD, DVD, or slide format.

DO NOT send actual original art works. Digital work files must be sent on a Windows - compatible CD-ROM in JPEG format. Each file should be named with the artist's surname and a number that corresponds to an identification sheet (example: Smith_01). Images should be at least 72 dpi in resolution and not larger than 3 MB per image. Examples of visual art include, but are not limited to, paintings, drawings, sculpture, pottery and fabrics. The committee cannot return the CD rom.

6. Include a certified copy of your academic transcript.
7. List the community service projects that you have been involved with, dates of service, the service provided, your role in the project and the organization/community served.
8. Attach a copy of your letter(s) of acceptance to any college, university or post-secondary school. Also have your recommendation letter sent directly from the recommender to the address below.
9. Deliver a copy of the application, digital artwork, certified copy of transcript, acceptance letter(s), essay and resume to the address or e-mail listed below by April 1, 2009 for consideration:
